We will be outdoors all day and do a food workshop together, where we will eat with the horses and donkeys 🐎🐴. All food will be locally sourced from the premises and vegan/vegetarian. We will leave **Kultivator at 15:45** to be back at **Kalmar C at ca. 16.30.**

What to bring:

- Good clothes for different weather (The weather prognoses are ☀️sunny🌧️, 13-18° Celsius)
 - Wellington boots / trainers / shoes (that can get wet or dirty)
you don't have to buy shoes specifically for this trip, if you don't have any water-proof shoes, bring two plastic bags that you can put on your shoes, if it would start to rain.
 - Warm jumper
 - Rain / wind proof jacket
 - Hat/ sunglasses (the choice is yours)
- Something to sit on, if it is wet, for example plastic bag with a newspaper inside.
- Water bottle / Or other drink (the choice is yours)
- Snacks to keep your blood sugar levels even or if you get hungry before and after lunch. For example, a fruit, chocolate, energy bar . . . (the choice is yours)
- Projectbook / (+ sketchpad)
- Minimum of 5 different materials to work with, you decide how much material you want to bring. **Remember you can also share with each other.** For example:
 - Pencils
 - Watercolour pencils
 - Crayon
 - Felt tips
 - Oil pastels
 - Graphite stick
 - Tipex (if you have, no need to buy)
 - Brushes

We, the teachers will bring black ink and charcoal that you can use during the day.

- A bottle of water for mixing ink and watercolour
- Toilet paper or kitchen towel
- Masking tape (if you have any)
- Some kind of sound / video recording device (Your phone is fine)

It is good to prepare your projectbook. For example, adding different coloured paper into your sketchbook, so that you are not always sketching on white background.
