Obtaining a student account and register

MyMoodle –the digital learning platform–class room

You will reach your pages on the learning platform when you login with your student account, using the same details you use for login at Lnu.se/Student. We use a digital learning platform called MyMoodle. It is very important that you are acquainted with the learning platform. This is where important announcements will be made, where you will have access to the schedule and it will be a tool that we use to communicate with you, so please keep an eye on it.
