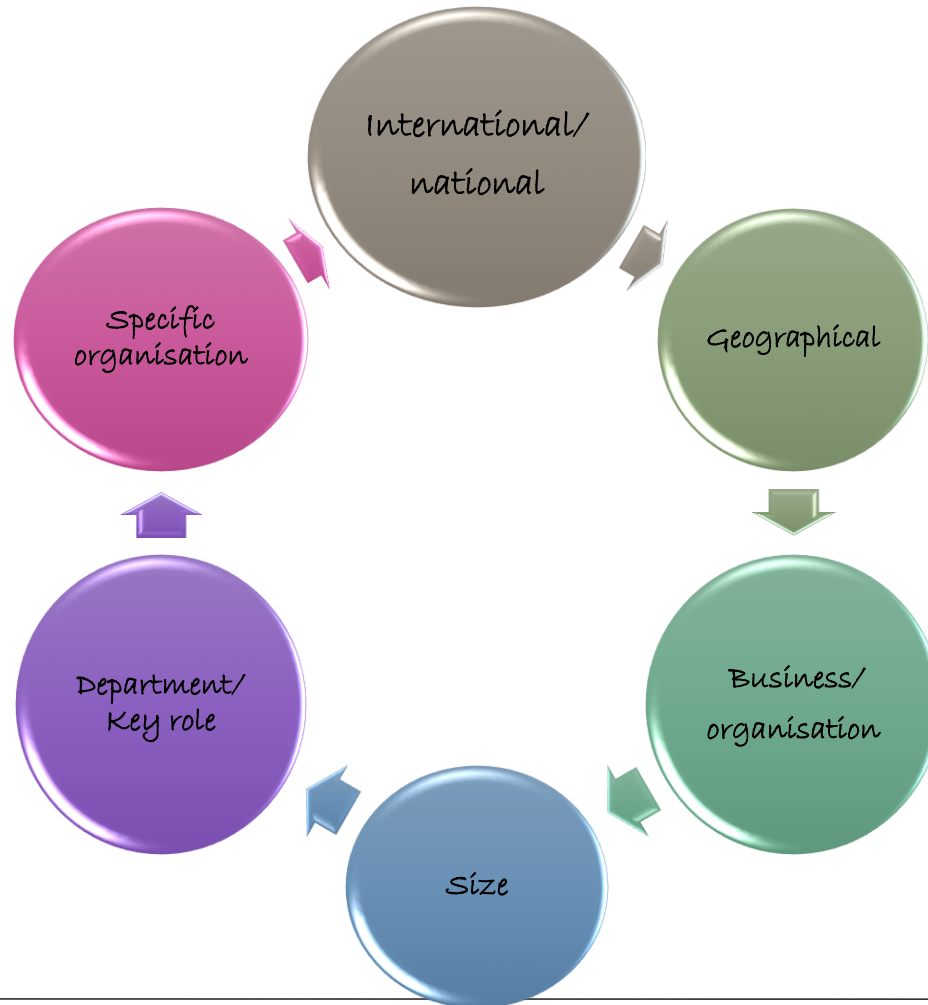


Advice and your competitive advantage as students
