Student Mobility Grant within Linnaeus-Palme Partnership Framework for Exchange Studies in INDIA or GHANA in Autumn Semester 2022.

Linnaeus-Palme is a programme funded by the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) and aimed to strengthen the cooperation between Swedish academic institutions and counterparts in developing countries in order to increase global connections in the academic world.

## Available Funding:

The School of Business and Economics offers currently a funding and an opportunity to engage in full-time exchange studies at the bachelor/master level at:

- 10 weeks:  
half semester, 15 credits, 2 courses
- Bachelor level studies
- 2 students in total

\*The grant is not intended to cover all expenses during the time abroad; it might need to be supplemented by other financing for example from CSN (Swedish Board of Student Finance).

## The Exchange Studies:

Will provide you with international experience and education that results in a qualification. You'll broaden your competence by accessing other knowledge, experience, traditions and problem-solving methods. You'll meet teachers and students in the same subject, but with an entirely different cultural background and academic tradition. It also provides you with the opportunity to share your own knowledge and to make contacts: a mutual exchange.

The Student Mobility Grant is available only for Autumn semester 2022 commencing:

At IMED: August 2022 through January 2022 (20 weeks in total)

At GIMPA: September 2022 through October/November 2022 (10 weeks in total)

## Eligibility Requirements:

The following requirements need to be fulfilled in order to qualify for the Student Mobility Grant:

- You have studied for at least one year at Bachelor level before starting the exchange at Bachelor level at partner institution; or at least one year at Master's level before starting the exchange at Master level at partner institution.
- You must be able to transfer the credits for your studies (the Programme Coordinator approves the Study Plan prior departure), with exception for post-programme studies.
- You must be a Swedish citizen or have permanent residency in Sweden, or a Nordic citizen who has been registered in Sweden for a least a year before departure.
- You are currently enrolled in one of the following study programmes at the School of Business and Economics:

Business Administration and Economics (Civilekonomprogrammet) – Specialisation  
Management (and plan the exchange semester on T5)  
Enterprising and Business Development  
Human Resource Management  
International Business  
International Tourism Management (post-programme)  
Retail Management  
Marketing  
Customer Experience Management

Entrepreneurship  
Innovation through Business, Engineering and Design - Specialisation Business  
Tourism and Sustainability  
International Business Strategy

and,

Leadership and Management in International Context (post-programme)
